NEW Leadership in After-School *Graduate-Level Certificate Program*

Hunter College, School of Education, in collaboration with the Center for After-School Excellence at TASC, will offer a three-course, nine-credit, graduate-level, non-degree program during the 2009-2010 academic year entitled "Leadership in After-School." After-school topics will be discussed in each class.

Courses included:

All courses will be held on Saturdays beginning late August 2009 and ending late June 2010.

Child Development

Theories and research will be applied to children's development. Understanding and working with children from diverse backgrounds to foster optimal growth.

Art of Effective Teaching

This course is designed to introduce educators to the world of urban education and their roles as quality educators.

Educational Psychology

This is an advanced educational psychology course that explores theories and research applied to learning, motivation, cognition, student and educator relationships, and classroom management with a focus on students from diverse backgrounds.

All those interested in applying to the certificate program must have already earned a bachelors degree, maintained a minimum G.P.A. of 2.8 and is currently working or volunteering at an after-school program. There is a nominal fee for this certificate.
